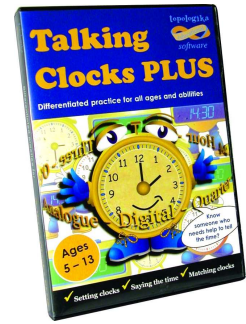


TALKING CLOCKS PLUS

Helping pupils tell the time on analogue and/or digital clocks.

Talking Clocks Plus gives pupils practice at telling the time using analogue and digital clocks. The four activities are: Say the Time (using onscreen words and numbers to type in the time presented by the onscreen clocks); Set the Clock (moving the clock's hands to show a time given in words); Match the Clocks (moving the hands on one clock to match another); and How Much Time? (calculating the difference between the times shown on two clocks). Each of these can be set at levels appropriate to pupils' ages and abilities.



Bright and friendly animated talking clocks interact with learners, showing them how the hands of a clock move and how digital numerals change.

Pupils can have just one 'go' or up to three, and can work against time, receiving continuous feedback with real speech. AM, PM or 24-hour times can be selected, from just the hours right down to any minute e.g. 1 o'clock or 18:30 pm.

Target learning by year and term with the software's 48 Numeracy Strategy-linked files, and choose from a choice of primary and adult digital and analogue clock styles.

The software is visually superb, easy to use and configure. Teacher control is a high quality feature and settings can be customised to extend any pupil. For pupils with reading difficulties, all times are spoken and written, and the teacher can choose between clear English male and female voices. Good quality, photocopiable worksheets are provided to encourage

pupils to work away from the computer.

The supporting documentation includes a booklet which is clearly laid out, and several worksheets which can be photocopied to support the work done on the computer. These include clocks with hands missing so that teachers can be more flexible in their choice of worksheet activities.

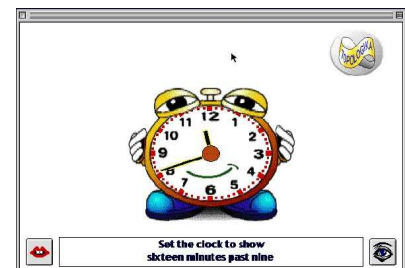

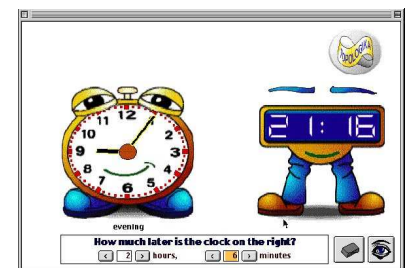
System requirements
